Students also have the opportunity to acquire proficiency certificates reflecting their level of foreign language competency and, according to their level, will be able to test out of part or all foreign language requirements.
- Public Affairs Capstone Experience: internship or education abroad
- **Minor required (or second major)** Note: no more than nine hours may count toward both the major and a minor.
- **Double majors:** Students wishing to pursue the Global Studies major and another major (no minor required) may only count up to nine hours in both majors.
